VINEYARD CHARACTER

Land's Edge Pinot Noir is sourced predominately from our estate's Far Coast Vineyard, located north of the Russian River in the Sonoma Coastal Mountain Range, overlooking the Pacific Ocean. Because there is only one ridge between the ocean and the vineyards, Far Coast and our other properties such as Seascape, located at the 'Land's Edge', are driven by a maritime influence producing a small but concentrated crop of Pinot Noir that is picked in October and sometimes into November. The cool and foggy coastal climate preserves natural acidity in the grapes and helps delineate the purity of fruit flavors and expression of the unique coastal terroir in this wine. Balanced acidity, layers of complexity and firm tannins will allow for long and graceful aging of Land's Edge Vineyards Pinot Noir.

TASTING NOTES

Complex aromas of black cherry and blackberry are balanced with subtle anise and violet nuances. The layered flavors of ripe dark berries and dried flowers transition into hints of black tea and minerals, followed by a lingering silky finish.
